The EAFWH Wound Healing Programme ensures that physicians involved in wound management have a sufficient level of expertise to provide efficient and safe treatment of their patients.

To optimise the treatment of patients with chronic wounds, physicians must be able to select therapy appropriate to the underlying aetiology as well as the correct local therapeutic measures.

The programme includes the fundamentals of the medical field of wound healing, as well as information on the different pathogenetic causes of chronic wounds, clinical assessment, development of therapeutic concepts, wound prevention, and collaboration with other specialists, nurses, and health care providers dealing with this patient population.

Wound healing education programmes organised by the EAFWH are based on the curriculum approved by the European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS) Multidisciplinary Joint Committee of Wound Healing (MJC-WH).

Education programme graduates are awarded the title European Fellow of Wound Healing.

EAFWH fellows are invited to engage in the future development of the EAFWH association.

The EAFWH international educational programme is being organised in English.

Programme structure

- + Course introduction: Completion of an e-learning course (Link available four weeks before first face-to-face course).
- + Two face-to-face courses on 19-20 June and 25-26. Sep. 2020. (Friday 12.00-17.00 and Saturday 8.00-15.00).
A dinner for students and faculty will be arranged on Friday evening.
- + Online examination: Must be completed at the latest one month after completion of the 2nd course.
- + Submission of five case studies, maximum one year after successful examination.
- + Participation in two wound conferences: One conference of the European Wound Management Association EWMA. (www.ewma.org/ewma-conferences) and one national wound conference of your own choice at the latest one year after successful examination.

The fellowship must be re-certified in 4 years.

Price

The cost of the whole programme per course participant is EUR (€) 2,900

The programme has a maximum group size of 20 participants.
