## European Association of Fellows in Wound Healing International Wound Healing Programme

The EAFWH Educational Wound Healing Programme ensures that physicians involved in wound management have the necessary level of expertise to provide efficient and safe treatment for their patients. The programme is also a unique opportunity to become part of a multidisciplinary and multicultural network of medical doctors from all over the world.

To optimise the treatment of patients with chronic wounds, physicians must be able to select therapy appropriate to the underlying aetiology, as well as the correct local therapeutic measures.

The programme includes the fundamentals of wound healing, as well as information on the different pathogenetic causes of chronic wounds, clinical assessment, the development of therapeutic concepts, wound prevention,

and collaboration with other specialists, nurses, and healthcare providers dealing with this patient population.

Wound healing education programmes organised by the EAFWH are based on the curriculum approved by the European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS) Multidisciplinary Joint Committee of Wound Healing (MJC-WH).

**Graduates of the programme are awarded the title of European Fellow of Wound Healing.**

EAFWH fellows are invited to engage in the future development of the EAFWH association.

The programme has a maximum group size of 20 participants.  
A dinner for students and faculty will be arranged during the face-to-face course.

### Programme structure

- Course introduction: An e-learning course in Basic Wound Healing must be completed prior to the first course. A link for accessing this will be available approx. three weeks before the first course.
- Online examination: Must be completed at the latest 1 month after completion of the second course.
- Participants will have a period of 6 months to submit five case reports following participation in the second course.
- Participation in two wound conferences: One international conference and one national wound conference of your own choice at the latest approx. 6 months after participation in the second course.

The fellowship must be re-certified in 4 years. Details about recertification will be provided at a later stage.

### Price

The cost of the whole programme per participant is EUR 2,900
